

RESOLUTION NO. 54-10
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISADVANTAGED
BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE) GOALS FOR 2010-2013

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants to states through the Federal Transportation Administration (FTA) to support capital and operating assistance projects for nonurbanized public transportation systems under Section 5307 of the FTA Act of 1964, as amended, and;


WHEREAS, the Michiana Area Council of Governments being the duly designated Metropolitan Planning Organization for the South Bend and Elkhart/Goshen Urbanized Areas, in cooperation with local governmental units and implementing agencies within the urbanized areas, administers transit programs in Elkhart and Goshen, and;

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration requires that the Michiana Area Council of Governments develop a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program and a Three-Year DBE goal in conjunction with FTA-assisted procurements;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Michiana Area Council of Governments approves the following DBE participation goals be approved for FTA-assisted procurements: a goal of 8.0% in 2010-2011, a goal of 6.0% in 2011-2012, and a goal of 6.0% 2012-2013.
