

RESOLUTION NO. 46-11
A RESOLUTION OF THE MICHIANA AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS
SUPPORTING THE STATE HISTORIC BYWAY DESIGNATION FOR
OLD LINCOLN HIGHWAY.

WHEREAS, The Michiana Area Council of Governments (MACOG) the designated Metropolitan Planning Area representing the South Bend and Elkhart/Goshen Urbanized Areas, as well as Elkhart, Kosciusko, Marshall and St. Joseph Counties in Indiana, has established a region-wide, cooperative, comprehensive and continuing planning process to develop the unified work program, long-range transportation plan and transportation improvement program; and

WHEREAS, The MACOG enacts the plans and programs to facilitate federal, state and local funding for surface transportation improvements carried out by the Indiana Department of Transportation, the region's communities, counties and transit operators, and provides technical assistance and expertise to regional transportation interests; and

WHEREAS, the Indiana Historic Byway Program recognizes the historic importance of certain roads which contributed greatly to the growth and development of our State; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln Highway in Indiana is a significant feature to the history and understanding of our State, region and communities; and

WHEREAS, the Indiana Lincoln Highway Association has applied for the designation of Old Lincoln Highway as a State Historic Byway.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that MACOG hereby endorses the application of the Indiana Lincoln Highway Association for the designation of the 1913 and 1928 alignments of Old Lincoln Highway as a State Historic Byway.
