

RESOLUTION 06-12
A RESOLUTION ENDORSING AN APPLICATION BY THE COUNCIL ON AGING OF
ELKHART COUNTY FOR PROCUREMENT OF CAPITAL EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the SAFETEA-LU Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy of Users (2005) designating joint Federal Highway Administration/Federal Transit Administration rules and regulations, under Section 134, Title 23 of the US Code (h) and CFR, Part 450, Sub-part A, of the previous STAA act require the annual preparation of a Transportation Improvement Program by the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization(s) as a part of the transportation planning process in urbanized areas of 50,000 or more population; and

WHEREAS, the Michiana Area Council of Governments (MACOG) being the duly designated Metropolitan Planning Organization for the South Bend and Elkhart/Goshen Urbanized Areas, in cooperation with local governmental units and implementing agencies within the Urbanized areas, has prepared FY2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Programs (TIP), Which consists of improvements recommended in the MACOG Region.

WHEREAS, the MACOG Policy Board from time to time receives requests for endorsement of Applications under Section 5310 of 49 U.S.C. to procure vehicles for non-profit agencies,

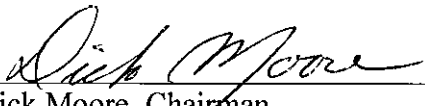
BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the MACOG Policy Board endorses the projects shown Below and submission of the Council on Aging of Elkhart County application.
